

DESCRIPTION AND APPLICATIONS

The Electro-Voice model 307 suspension shock mount adapts to boom use any microphone having a cylindrical %-inch diameter case. It may be attached directly to a microphone boom or floor stand. Where boom shadows tend to limit freedom of the microphone movement, a model 306 extension arm should be used.

The 307 shock mount permits quick installation or removal of a microphone without tools. A molded plastic support grips the microphone snugly and is supported by two molded neoprene shock cords to provide maximum isolation from shock.

The Electro-Voice 306 extension arm/307 shock mount assembly can be boom or stand mounted to provide shock isolation for the RE10, RE11, RE15, RE16, RE55, 635A, 649B, or other microphones having cylindrical 4-inch diameter barrels.




Figure 1 - 306 Extension Arm Dimensions




Figure 2 - 307 Shock Mount Dimensions
